

# Claude Monet

## Activity 1 : Learn about the life of Claude Monet

Watch this clip <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ah5g2M14oUM> and read the [artist fact sheet](#) (or ask a grown up to read it to you) to learn all about Monet. There's an [additional PowerPoint](#) for older pupils too. Then **write a fact file** all about Claude Monet. Can you make a simple timeline of his life or find a photograph of the artist? Try to include facts about what kind of paintings he did, the techniques he used, his life and where he lived. Artists often have had interesting lives, can you find out an unusual fact about the artist?

## Activity 2: Monet's Garden finger painting

Read the [PowerPoint](#) on Monet's Garden to learn more about Monet's paintings and the technique he used. Then have a go at recreating one of these painting of his garden – there is a template included for younger pupils if they'd like to use that to paint over instead of sketching the outline.

## Activity 3: Painting Monet's Water lilies
