

## One Way System for Drop off and Pick up time

Please follow our one-way system during drop off and pick-up times to help keep the children of Crossdale safe.

One Way System – Come towards school on Crossdale Drive and leave on Brockwood Crescent.

Please also try to show courtesy and consideration for the residents of Crossdale Drive and the surrounding roads.



## Road Closure

Please remember that the roads leading to / from school will be closed from 29<sup>th</sup> September to 2<sup>nd</sup> October for resurfacing works. Please walk / cycle / scoot where possible, but if you do need to drive, you will need to park away from school and then walk. Please also allow extra time for the school drop off / pick-ups during this period.

## Extra Layers

As the weather gets colder it's advisable for children to come to school in extra layers. We have to keep good ventilation throughout the building which means we will continue to keep windows and some doors open, and although we will have our heating on, children may feel more comfortable having extra layers on, which they can remove if they get too warm!





## Stay safe cycling to school

If your child / children cycle to school, please ensure that they wear a cycle helmet. There is a lot of evidence that shows that helmets have been effective in reducing potential injury to a young cyclist's head/brain in the event of a fall or impact.
