#### ScholarPack Parents – A New App



As a school we are now using ScholarPack Parents, a new app which lets us communicate with you and shows you information held by the school on your child to ensure that everything is kept up to date. You will only be able view your own contact details and you will have the facility, in some cases, to respond directly through the app to messages. Please ensure that all details are correct and notify us of any changes needed as soon as possible.

Firstly, download the app by searching 'ScholarPack Parents' in Google or Apple mobile app stores. In order to complete the set up you need a link up code for your child/children. The link has been emailed to you already. This code will expire after 14 days so please sign up today.
