
Time to get festive – help us decorate our tree!

Please could we ask that everyone be mindful of maintaining a social distance when coming into and leaving school. It is vitally important that everyone tries to do their bit to help keep everyone as safe as possible.

After half term we adjusted our pick-up and drop off times in the hope that this would save parents and children congregating at the gates and would mean that we had a more efficient system of getting children into and out of school. Recently, we have noticed that some parents are bringing their children onto the playaround early which has meant that we have more adults and children on the playground than planned. We kindly ask that you try to ensure that you don't arrive too early for school to help ensure that there aren't too many people congregating on the playground at any one time. We will need to revert to a longer gap between drop-offs / pick-ups if we don't feel that things improve, in order to help try and keep everyone safe.
