

# Reception Curriculum Map Summer 1

Our curriculum consists of 7 areas of learning which we plan specific activities and experiences in the environment for the children to explore. Here are a few that we intend to introduce to the children this half term.

## Topic Question

**Can I switch it on?** This half term is all about different types of technology!

We will be looking at different types and uses of technology and how they help us. We will also be learning how we can keep safe on the internet.

## Mathematics

We will continue to learn about numbers to 20 and beyond as well as addition, subtraction and finally moving onto shapes.

We will be encouraging the children to be applying their skills by using their 'Maths Eyes'. More information to follow on Seesaw.

## Communication and Language

Retelling stories will be a big focus this half term which will support our 'Tales Toolkit' work.

## Literacy

In our literacy sessions will be beginning to explore how stories are constructed through 'Tales Toolkit' sessions.

Phonics will continue with the emphasis on 'Fred in your head', rereading for speed and fluency as well as reviewing and learning Set 2 sounds.

**Expressive Arts and Design**  
We will be exploring instruments and following musical patterns.

## Understanding the World

We will be learning to recognise that a range of technology is used in places such as homes and schools. The children will select and use technology for a particular purposes eg, taking photographs and making recordings.

## Physical Development

Mr Pharoee will continue to deliver fantastic PE sessions twice a week. We will also continue to practise writing letters correctly and applying these in weekly 'Super Sentences' and in News writing
