Year One – Owls – Mrs Morgan and Mrs Westmorland

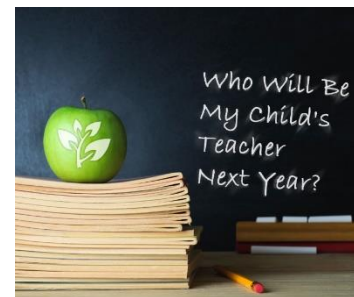
Year Two – Lime – Mrs Jones and Mrs Payne
