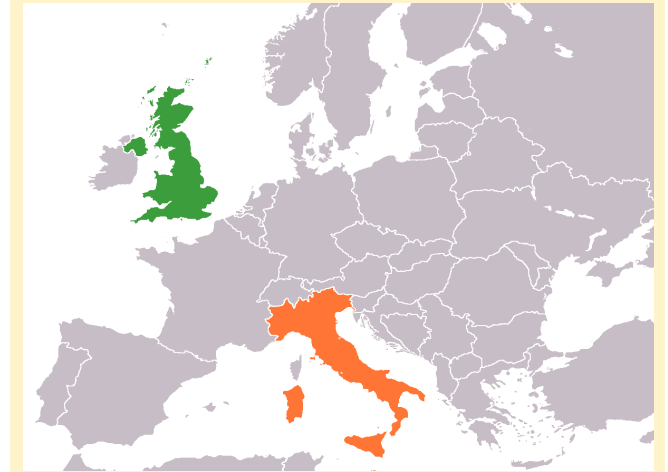

Britain and Italy are in the continent of Europe.



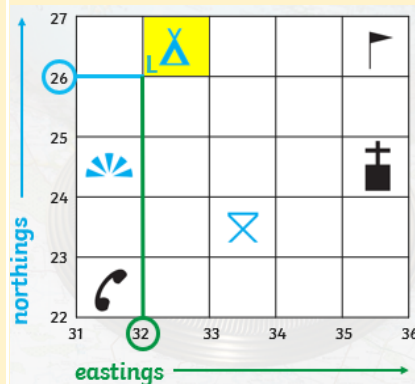
How did the Romans connect Britain? Roman Roads

Using 4 figure grids:

- 1) The first two numbers give the **eastings**.
- 2) The second two numbers give the **northings**.
- 3) The point where they meet is the bottom left-hand corner of grid square 3226.

Using 6 figure grids:

- 1) The first two numbers give the **eastings**.
- 2) The second two numbers give the **northings**.
- 3) Once you have located the grid square, the final two numbers locate within the square.
