

our Deputy Head Teachers.

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

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

sounds.





- We have aprons and sinks to wash our hands when we do really messy activities.




Some things are a little bit different at school than when you went to pre-school or nursery. We have toilets for girls and boys and standing up toilets for boys. Which ones will you use?
