How and why did WWI start?

On 28 June 1914, Archduke Franz Ferdinand, the heir to the throne of Austria-Hungary, was killed by a Serbian man.

Austria-Hungary declared war on Serbia.

Other countries became involved due to alliances and agreements to protect each other.
