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Christmas Jumper Day

On Friday 9th December, everyone is invited to wear a Christmas jumper to school for the day. On the day, we will be collecting donations for the 'save the children' charity. More information about the charity and the Christmas jumper day can be found on their website.

PE Kit

We are finding that a number of children still do not have the correct PE kit in school. It is important that children have their kit in school for each of their PE lessons as it ensures that children are appropriately dressed in order to take part in activities safely.

As published on our website, our PE kit consists of the following:

- a white, round-neck t-shirt*
- burgundy shorts (no logos)
- appropriate footwear trainers or plimsolls
- a plain, dark coloured tracksuit for the colder months

Most children are participating in indoor PE lessons this half term, and so they should have burgundy shorts and a white, round-neck t-shirt to wear. However, some lessons will be outdoors, and so it is important that they also have a plain, dark coloured tracksuit in their PE bag too.

As of Monday 5th December, we will be introducing a new system in school to ensure children have the correct kit:

- On the first occasion children do not have the correct kit, they
 will need to watch the PE lesson and a reminder text to parents
 / carers will be sent home.
- On the second occasion kit isn't in school, for children in R Y4, they will be provided with pre-loved PE kit to wear. A phone call home to parents / carers will be made. For children in base 3, they will have timeout in which they will write a reminder note about bringing their PE kit into school.
- On the third occasion kit isn't in school, children will have a time out and children in base 2 and 3 will write a reminder note about bringing their PE kit into school.

If you are experiencing any difficulties in ensuring your child has the correct PE kit, for any reason, please do not hesitate to speak to either Mr Cresswell, Mrs Westie or Miss Seedhouse.
