
What do I already know? Children have already learnt that human have five senses - sight, touch, taste, hearing and smelling. These senses are linked to particular parts of the body which they children have labelled.



mammal	Mammals are animals that breathe air, grow hair or fur and feed on their mother's milk as a baby.	
fish	Fish live and breathe under water. They have scaly skin, fins to help them swim and they breathe through gills.	
amphibi- an	Amphibians live in the water as babies and on land as they grow older. They have smooth, slimy skin.	
reptile	All reptiles breathe air. They have scales on their skin.	
bird	All birds have a beak, two legs, feathers and wings.	
habitat	The natural home of an animal.	
diet	The food an animal eats.	










