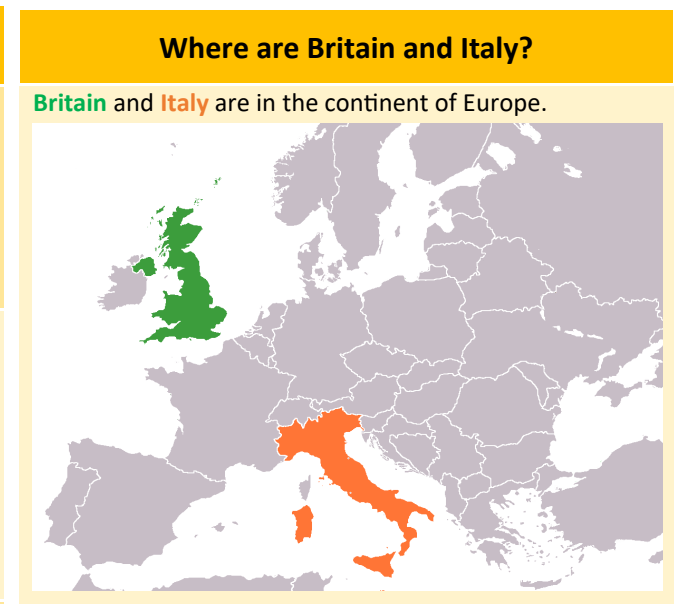


The Celts and Romans: locate ancient settlements on maps + compare and contrast Italy & Britain

Key Vocabulary	
coastlands	Land on the shores (edge) of a country.
continent	A collection of countries located in one area.
eastings	The first 2 numbers in a 4 figure grid reference.
grid reference	A code used to accurately locate your location on a detailed map.
northings	The last 2 numbers in a 4 figure grid reference.
midlands	Land in the centre of a country.

climate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • four seasons • temperature varies: colder in high altitudes, warmer along the coast. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • four seasons • temperature varies: colder in the north, warmer in the south.
land height	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1/3 covered in mountains • contains a part of the Alps mountain range • tallest peak: 4810m, Mont Blanc 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • mainly lowland • contains the Grampian Mountain Range • tallest peak: 1345m, Ben Nevis
landscape	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • lakes and mountains in the north • hilly forests in the midlands • hot, dry coastlands in the south 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • hillier areas in north west • forests and flat plains in the midlands and south.



How did the Romans connect Britain? Roman Roads



Using 4 figure grids:

3226

- 1) The first two numbers give the **eastings**.
- 2) The second two numbers give the **northings**.
- 3) The point where they meet if the bottom left-hand corner of grid square 3226.

Using 6 figure grids:

015795

- 1) The first two numbers give the **eastings**.
- 2) The second two numbers give the **northings**.
- 3) Once you have located the grid square, the final two numbers locate within the square.
