

Using 4 figure grids:

- 1)The first two numbers give the eastings.
- 2)The second two numbers give the northings.
- 3)The point where they meet if the bottom left-hand corner of grid square 3226.



- 1)The first two numbers give the eastings.
- 2)The second two numbers give the northings.
- 3)Once you have located the grid square, the final two numbers locate within the square.
