- ✓ Make sure that you have the £2.00 donation needed to see it delivered
- Please remember this may be the only Christmas gift a child or senior citizen will receive
- To make sure that your gift arrives on time for Christmas please ensure that it is collected by your local co-ordinator or delivered to the designated drop- off centres.
