

Key Stage 2 Results 2023

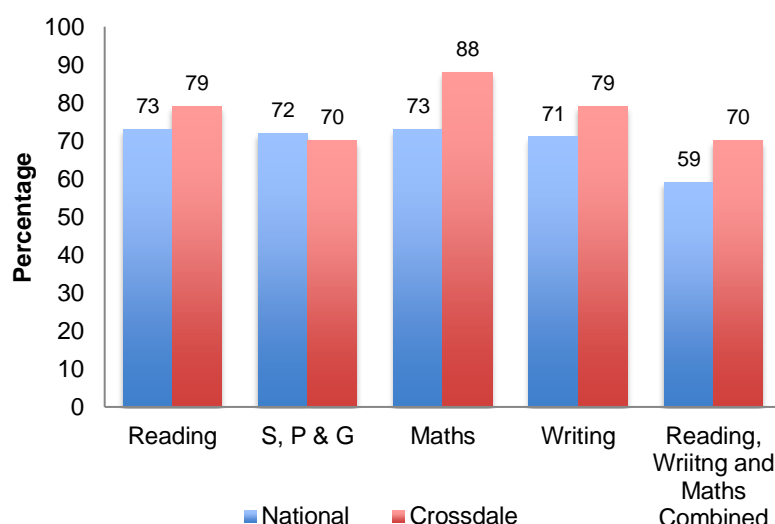
Assessments in 2023

The statistics below cover the attainment of year 6 pupils who took assessments in summer 2023. These pupils experienced disruption to their learning during the pandemic, particularly at the end of year 3 and in year 4. Attainment nationally in combined reading, writing and maths has decreased compared to pre-pandemic (2019), down from 65%.

59% of pupils nationally in 2023 reached the expected standard in reading, writing and maths

At CROSSDALE 70% of pupils reached the expected standard in reading, writing and maths.

Comparative data – National vs CROSSDALE 2023 Individual Subjects



The expected standard in the tests is a scaled score of 100 or above. The range for scaled scores is between 80 and 120. The graph to the left shows the percentage of pupils scoring above 100.

Attainment in the tests nationally is highest in maths and reading at 73% and lowest in writing at 71%.

The scaled score range runs from 80 to 120 with 100 as the expected standard.
