chief field shield	It is the odd one out because...
thief chief tried	It is the odd one out because...

Odd One Out Spellings Answers

This week, we are looking at the vowel digraph 'ie' and the two sounds it can make - /igh/ and /ee/. Look at each group of words and circle the odd one out. Write a sentence to explain why it is the odd one out.

'ie' Word	Why is it the odd one out?
lie thief tie	It is the odd one out because... <i>'ie' is making the /ee/ sound not /igh/</i>
cried dried tie	It is the odd one out because... <i>the 'ie' is at the end of the word</i>
chief field shield	It is the odd one out because... <i>this word does not rhyme with shield and field</i>
thief chief tried	It is the odd one out because... <i>'ie' is making the /igh/ sound not /ee/</i>
