Year 3/4 Spelling

dis- and **mis-** have negative meanings.

dis-

disappoint
disagree
disobey



mis-

misbehave
mislead
misspell


Pattern

Year 3/4 Spelling

Short -i sound spelt with a **y other than at the end of a word.**

Example words:

**myth, gym, Egypt,
pyramid, mystery**



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The prefix **in-** means '**not**' or '**into**',
e.g. **incorrect**.

Example words:

**incorrect, invisible, inactive,
inappropriate**




Pattern

Year 3/4 Spelling

The short **u sound spelt **-ou-**.**

Example words:

**young, touch, double,
trouble, country**



Prefixes

Year 3/4 Spelling

inter- means 'between' or 'among'.

Example words:

interact, international,
intercity, interspersed

re- means 'again' or 'back'.

Example words:

redo, refresh, return, reappear, return,
redecorate

super- means 'above'.

Example words:

supermarket, superhero,
superstar

sub- means 'under'.

Example words:

subdivide, subheading,
submarine, submerge
