Year 3/4 Spelling

dis- and **mis-** have negative meanings.

dis-

disappoint

disagree

disobey

mis-

misbehave

mislead

misspell



Pattern

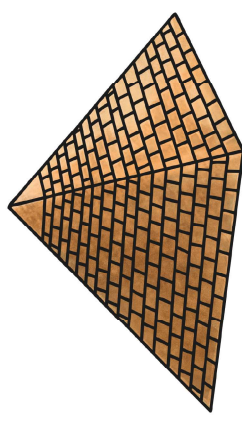
Year 3/4 Spelling

Short **-i** sound spelt with a **y** other than at the end of a word.

Example words:

myth, gym, Egypt,

pyramid, mystery



Prefixes

Year 3/4 Spelling

The prefix **in-** means '**not**' or '**into**', e.g. incorrect.

Example words:

incorrect, **in**visible, **in**active,

inappropriate



Pattern

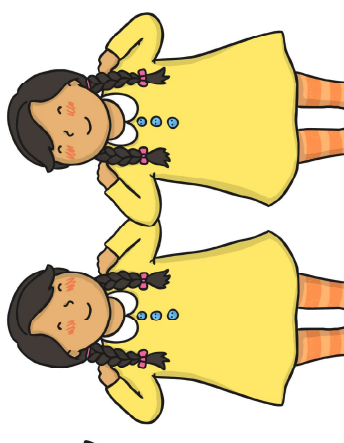
Year 3/4 Spelling

The short **u** sound spelt **-ou-**.

Example words:

young, touch, double,

trouble, country



Prefixes

Year 3/4 Spelling

inter- means 'between' or 'among'.

Example words:

interact, international,
intercity, interspersed

Year 3/4 Spelling

re- means 'again' or 'back'.

Example words:

redo, refresh, return, reappear, return,
redecorate



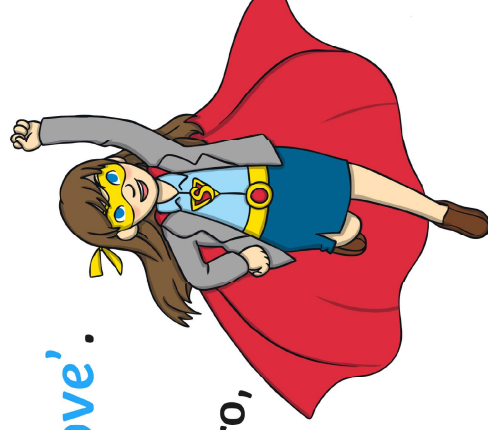
Prefixes

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super- means 'above'.

Example words:

supermarket, superhero,
superstar

Example words:

subdivide, subheading,
submarine, submerge
