What do I already know? The children have a developing understanding of the past through previous topics: The Great Fire of London, Castles topic and Victorian Seaside holidays. Many children will have experience of visiting a doctors surgery or hospital. Children are familiar with some famous historical figures e.g. William the Conqueror and Guy Fawkes.
