Things to do to help you to learn these spellings:

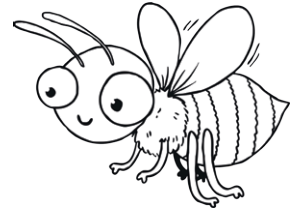
- Look, say, cover, write, check.
