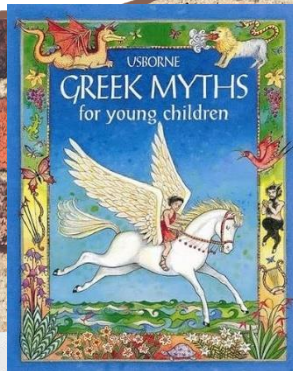
Reading & Comprehension Skills
