
## **Fair Trade**

## James Lind (1716-1794)

- James Lind worked with sailors who were suffering from an illness called scurvy.
- Sailors with scurvy were tired and their joints and muscles were weak and achy.
- Lind discovered that scurvy was caused by a lack of vitamin C and eating citrus fruits could cure the disease.



## How do grapes reach our fruit bowl? Growing 1. In Spain, a country in Europe, grapes are grown on large vineyards. 2. Farmers have to make sure the plants have enough water, are **supported** when the grapes become heavy and are sprayed with pesticides to get rid of insects. Harvesting 3. Grapes can be harvested **2 years** after planting. 4. They are harvested by hand and taken to a warehouse. The grapes are sorted into bunches, washed and packed into boxes. Transportation 5. Lorries collect the grapes from the warehouse and take them to the docks. They are packed into refrigerated cargo ships. It takes around 1 day for the grapes to reach the UK. 6. When they arrive at their destination, they are unloaded from the ship and transported to another warehouse. They are then transported by lorry to shops and supermarkets

around the country.
