Go on a walk with a grown-up and collect signs of the current season (e.g. autumn leaves, conkers, acorns, pinecones).

Sort them at home and create a "Season Box" or collage.

Extension: Label each item and write a sentence:

Draw a picture of what the world looks like in the current season (trees, sky, clothes, animals).

Extension: Add labels or a sentence: "The trees have no leaves because it's winter."

Keep a weather diary for 5 days. Each day, draw the sky and write or record the temperature (if possible).

Use words like sunny, cloudy, rainy, windy, cold, warm.

Extension: Compare the weather to another season: "In summer it was warmer."

Please choose I activity and bring in for our showcase lesson on Monday 8th December.

Lay out clothes you would wear in the current season.

Take a photo or draw them.

Extension: Write or say why each item is useful: "I wear my coat because it's cold."

Interview a family member: "What do you like or notice about this season?"
Write or draw their answer.

Extension: Compare answers with your own ideas.
