- Find out about famous Roman locations in Britain and create a collage with pictures, drawings and captions explaining where these places are and what they were used for.
- Write a list of Celtic names (10—20). Did you recognise any of the names? Are they still used today?
- Make a list of objects that we use nowadays that the Romans also used or maybe even invented.
- Find pictures of and draw Celtic patterns which they used in their textile, blacksmith and jewellery designs. Have you seen them before? Have a go at drawing a Celtic knot!
- Choose a times table and write it out using Roman numerals.
- Find out what the Romans typically ate and drank and use these to design a menu for a Roman café.
- Find images of Celtic artefacts in museums today. What items have survived from these times? What materials are they made from? Who would have owned them?
