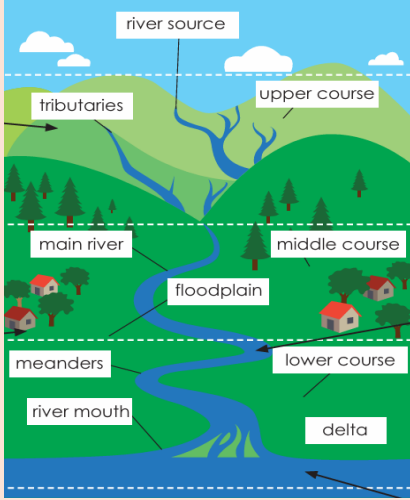


What is the land like in the UK and how do we use it?

Vocabulary	Definition
River	A natural, moving stream of water that flows downhill across the land
Peak	The top of a mountain
County	An area of England that has its own council
Rural	The countryside
Urban	A built-up area like a town or city
Council	A group of people who run a city or town
Land use	What land is used for

Rivers

- There are lots of rivers in the UK
- Rivers flow downhill from source to mouth
- Upper course -> middle course -> lower course




Counties

- England is split into counties
- Our county is Nottinghamshire



Mountains

Raised land
Taller than hills
Steeper than hills



Hills

Raised land
More sloped
Not as tall as mountains



Settlements

- A settlement is where people live
- Different sizes
- City -> Town -> Village -> Hamlet
