

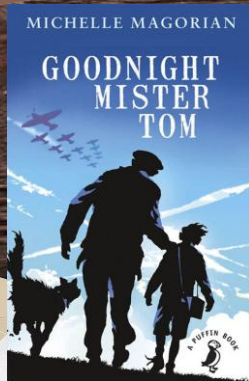
Autumn One in Year 6

English

Poetry: we will be writing our own Japanese haiku poems which have specific constraints.

Narrative based on our Talk For Writing text: Smaug. The focus will be on using our action toolkit to make our stories exciting. We will also be developing our skills in writing openings and endings to stories.

We are reading...



We will be reading Michelle Magorian's Goodnight Mr Tom this term, which tells the story of a young boy who is evacuated from London to the countryside, to live with an older man, called Thomas. The pair form a close bond as the Second World War develops.

Maths

- Place Value, extending to numbers beyond 1 million
- Calculation: Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division
- Word problems to develop reasoning and problem solving skills
- Regular times tables practice.
